**Directions**

Take I-74 east to the I-474/Route 6 Interchange. Exit I-74 onto Route 6/Chillicothe. Take Route 6 north to the War Memorial exit (may also be called Route 150). After exiting, turn right onto Route 91. Stay on Route 91 into Dunlap. Dunlap High School is on the south edge of Dunlap just off Route 91. Turn right off Route 91 at the first crossroad (Legion Hall Road) and this street will take you to the high school. The address is 5200 W. Legion Hall Rd, Dunlap, IL 61525.

**Bus Parking and Drop Off Site**

All students should be dropped off in the front of Dunlap High School in the semi-circle drive and enter through the main entrance. There will be a check-in just inside the door and you will be directed to rehearsal sites. Buses should park in the south side of the main high school parking lot. If you have a small number of students and are coming by van or car you may also park in the main high school parking lot. Coffee and donuts will be available in the foods lab (room A-6) for bus drivers.

**Directors Information and Registration**

We will have a director check-in table at the main entrance of the building. **Please plan to attend the directors' meetings: JEM directors will have a meeting and reading session (sponsored by Kidder Music) at 9:30 in Room A-7. Other directors will meet at 9:30am in the ART-1 Room (next to band and chorus rooms).** An assortment of food items will be available in the ART-1 Room for all directors.

**Concessions**

There will be a concession stand set up in the Dunlap Commons area with items at reasonable prices. Please encourage students to remain at Dunlap for lunch, as there are no fast food restaurants in close proximity. The Dunlap Music Boosters will be running all concessions in the school. **All food and drink must be consumed in the Commons area.**

**Student Dress**

Students may dress casually during the day for rehearsals. Please have them bring clothing which would be appropriate for formal concert appearance. Restrooms will serve as dressing facilities.

### **REHEARSAL FACILITIES AND SCHEDULES**

Students should bring the following: their own instruments (including drum set), any supplies for their instruments (reeds, valve oil, mutes, patch cords, sticks, etc.), music and a pencil. **Jazz band bass and guitar players, please make sure to bring your own amps and cords and any other special equipment you might need. Music stands will be provided.** The rehearsal rooms will serve as homerooms for each group, and you may leave equipment in them throughout the day. Please adhere closely to the rehearsal schedule, since all six groups are sharing the performance sites. Please note that all belongings must be removed from the performance areas prior to the concerts. Dunlap High School will not be responsible for lost or stolen equipment.
