Each year, there are a few schools scrambling to get this fee paid in September so they can enter student names for IMEA Participation. Don't let that be you next fall!

Detailed instructions to update your profile

Every director must update their profile annually after April 1st. The first time you log in this year, you are prompted to update your profile. Once you update, you get a check next to your name on my Director List. Don't forget to click the buttons for Band, Chorus, Orchestra, Jazz Band, Vocal Jazz and General Music. The reps will not even see your name unless you do this. It is very important to check all that apply so you get specific emails from the reps in each area.

If you are NEW to your school, you need to get the "Faculty Password" from the Contact Person at your school. Not sure who the contact person is . . .

4. Print your Audition Summary sheet from the web site and pay Audition fees to Frank Lestina
5. After students are selected for the District Festival, send Participation fees to STATE OFFICE.
You will also print this invoice from the new web site after auditions (more info later).
6. If you have students selected to ALL-STATE - send Participation fees to STATE OFFICE.

District President's Message Continued

IF YOU ARE NEW TO YOUR SCHOOL: Go to www.ilalldist.org Select District 7, then your school, then click the "Add Director" button. You will need a "Faculty Password" to add your name. You may then add your own password. The next screen MAY be the "Not Authorized for 2009" screen. This means the state has not received your School Participation Fee yet. Please make sure someone from your school sends this in before the end of the school year.

The Contact Person at each school controls the Faculty Password for each school and this is the person (at the high school) who gets the All-State Packet in the mail in December. The contact person has two extra items on their profile:

1.) The Faculty Password 2.) A DELETE button to delete staff members who have retired, moved on, or angered them in some way. I can change the Contact Person at your school. Send me an email to let me know if you need that changed.

About FUTURE Festival Sites

The largest challenge for District 7 is finding THREE sites for our festivals each fall. We are fortunate to have our three sites all set again for this fall. My goal is to have tentative sites for the following year by the November festivals. Yes, **NOW is the time to be thinking about hosting in the fall of 2010!** The key to the success of any organization is for all the members to share the responsibility. Few of us have facilities large enough to host the Senior Band, Orchestra and Choir Festival. I hope to continue rotating between the 5 or 6 schools with adequate facilities to host this festival. Please continue to let these directors know how grateful we are for their efforts each year.

Many schools are able to host the **Jazz Festival** since the site requirements are less demanding. Please consider taking your turn to host this festival. Another option to "share in the IMEA responsibility" is to host the **Junior / Elementary Festival**. Think of the great public relations this would create with your feeder school staff, parents and administration. Please consider hosting one of these festivals in the next few years and contact me if you have any questions.

Get Involved in IMEA: Remember, this is your association! Get involved, stay informed and urge your colleagues and friends in neighboring schools to participate in IMEA activities. Their students will benefit and we all know that increased school participation (at the senior level) allows for more District 7 students at All-State. Call those colleagues "down the road" who haven't been participating or who are new and urge them to give IMEA a try this fall. It will be a "win-win" situation for everyone! Please consider an IMEA office, hosting rehearsals or perhaps host a festival as mentioned above.
