****INDICATES AUDITION SELECTIONS.** Again, this fall, Junior Chorus will be an auditioned group. Students will follow the same audition procedures as the other groups. This change seems to have had a positive effect on our group. It also

allows chorus students the same advantages in the audition process as the instrumentalists.

* As with the other groups there will be a \$5.00 fee for each student

* You will not be allowed to make changes in students selected.

**** Each student will sing a major and a minor triad as well as a major scale and a HARMONIC minor scale. The student may choose the starting pitch - but the***

judge WILL NOT play along on the piano.

*** Remember: 9th grade students should audition for Senior Level.**

*** Make sure to enter the correct voice part during the on line entry process. Changing voice parts at auditions will not be allowed.**
