PRIOR TO ARRIVING AT CONFERENCE

## HOTEL INFORMATION

**Chaperones:** It is imperative that ALL students know the name of his/her Chaperone prior to the Conference.

**Check-In:** Only the Chaperone should check in the students for which he/she is responsible. The Chaperone will then distribute room keys or cards to students.

**Storage:** Because of the early check in required for Thursday, January 28, it is very likely that your hotel room will **not** be ready for you upon arrival. For this reason, the Pere Marquette and Holiday Inn City Centre have set aside an area for luggage storage that may be used until your room is ready.

**Assignments:** You **must** stay in the room assigned to you. No exchanges will be allowed. We must be able to find you immediately in the event of an emergency. Room checks may be made at any time by IMEA Board members, hotel security, or authorized law enforcement.

**Room Charges:** No additional charges (meals or phone calls) may be made to your room. All long distance calls must be made at a pay phone.

**Curfew:** You must be IN YOUR ROOM by 12:00 midnight. Chaperones will be responsible for enforcing curfews and the hotels will have extra added security.

**Miscellaneous:** Rooms must be locked at all times. Do not leave valuables or money in your room. Neither the hotels nor IMEA can assume responsibility for losses. Any problem with your room, such as insufficient bedding, towels, etc., report immediately to the hotel desk. If this does not solve the problem, contact your director/chaperone.

## RULES

**School Rules** apply during your stay. Drinking, drugs, infraction of curfew, etc. will be dealt with in a most severe manner. Individual school authorities and parents will be notified immediately.

## NAME BADGES

**Audition Results** will be posted as follows: Band and Jazz ONLY--lower lobby of Hotel Pere Marquette. Orchestra ONLY--lower lobby of Holiday Inn City Centre. We intend to post by 5:00 p.m.

## ATTENDANCE

**ATTENDANCE** for all rehearsals and scheduled events is **MANDATORY**. If you are just on time, you will be late! Please arrive early enough for a thorough warm-up.

If, for unavoidable reasons such as illness or injury, you must stay in your room, you must notify (1)-your School Director, (2)-your Organization Chair and (3)-the IMEA headquarters. You are not to stay in your room alone without adult permission and supervision.
