Submission Guidelines & Procedures:

- 1. Submit to <u>mte@ilmea.org</u>.
- 2. Submission of an article implies that it has not been previously published and has not been submitted for publication elsewhere.
- 3. The article should not exceed 2,500 words.
- 4. Include a biography of no more than 100 words including author's name, affiliation, and contact information.
- 5. Use the style manual appropriate for the genre.
